2013 Glaetzer Amon-Ra

Inky purple. Deep smoke-and spice-accented aromas of cassis, blueberry liqueur, Indian spices and sandalwood, with bright minerality adding lift and definition. Lush, creamy dark berry flavors are youthfully fresh, with a spine of acidity adding vivacity. Very deep but improbably lithe, finishing with emphatic sweetness and clarity and gently tannic persistence.



2013 Glaetzer Anaperenna

Inky purple. Lush blueberry and blackberry aromas show an enticing blend of depth and vivacity, with a suave incense nuance adding interest. Intense dark fruit liqueur flavors are supported by zesty acidity and show superb clarity for their power. Stinkingly deep and sweet on the long, penetrating finish, which features velvety tannins and lingering blue fruit character.

2013 Glaetzer Bishop

Dark purple. Powerful, seductively perfumed bouquet evokes ripe blackberry, blueberry, roasted coffee, licorice and smoky minerals. Densely packed yet lively, with a supple, seamless texture to the seet dark fruit and floral pastille flavors. The blue fruit and licorice qualities carry through the finish, which is framed by smooth, even tannins.



2013 Glaetzer Wallace

Inky purple. Powerful aromas of blueberry, blackberry, woodsmoke and violet. Displays supple, open-knit flavors of smoky dark fruits, mocha and candied flowers, with a peppery element adding lift. Shows very good clarity for its richness, with a sweet floral pastille note carrying through the long, smoky, gently tannic finish.
