2014 Glaetzer Amon-Ra

Deep garnet-purple colored, the 2014 Amon-Ra Shiraz has a youthfully mute nose, offering glimpses at the blackberry, blackcurrant and licorice core, plus suggestions of dark chocolate, cigar boxes, fertile earth and baking spices. The full-bodied palate delivers concentrated, muscular blackberry and earth flavors with plenty of freshness and a beautiful backbone of finely grained tannins, finishing with commendable persistence and layers. This is a great contender for wine of the vintage!

2014 Glaetzer Anaperenna

A blend of 76% Shiraz and 24% Cabernet Sauvignon, the deep garnet-purple colored 2014 Shiraz Cabernet Anaperenna has a nose of crème de cassis, plum preserves, blackberry coulis and chocolate box with hints of cigar boxes and baking spices. Big, opulent and voluptuously fruited in the mouth, it has nice ripe, velvety tannins and just enough acid to frame the generous fruit, finishing with great length and plenty of freshness.

2014 Glaetzer Bishop

Deep garnet-purple colored, the 2014 Bishop Shiraz has a wonderfully open-for-business, exotic spice-laced nose with a fragrant core of mulberries, black cherries and stewed plums, plus a menthol waft. Full-bodied, rich and spicy in the mouth, it fills the palate with black fruit preserves framed by velvety tannins and a lively backbone, finishing with great length.

2014 Glaetzer Wallace

A blend of 78% Shiraz and 22% Grenache, the 2014 Wallace is medium garnet in color with a gorgeous nose of black raspberries, kirsch and lavender plus black pepper, cloves and anise hints. Medium to full-bodied, the palate is soft, pepper-laced and seductive with impressive persistence and a lively acid and herb lift to the finish.
