Deep garnet-purple colored, the 2014 Bishop Shiraz has a wonderfully open-for-business, exotic spice-laced nose with a fragrant core of mulberries, black cherries and stewed plums, plus a menthol waft. Full-bodied, rich and spicy in the mouth, it fills the palate with black fruit preserves framed by velvety tannins and a lively backbone, finishing with great length.

2014 Bishop, **92 Points**

Bright violet color. Pungent, spicy scents of fresh dark berries, licorice, candied violet, vanilla and smoky minerals. Lively and precise on the palate, offering fresh black and blue fruit and bitter cherry flavors complemented by a hint of peppery spices. Becomes sweeter and deeper with air with no loss of vivacity, finishing sappy and very long, with supple tannins adding shape and grape.
