#### Amon-Ra Shiraz 2012

Full, deep purple-crimson; filled to the brim with blackberry, satsuma plum, licorice, spice and dark chocolate, it carries its alcohol without faltering; its well-inserted, high quality, cork should allow it to reach its destiny somewhere after its 21st birthday, supported by its supple, ripe tannins and integrated oak.



### 95 POINTS TITT

#### Anaperenna Shiraz Cabernet 2012

Youthful crimson-purple; a shiraz cabernet blend that has awesome depth, yet is not the least extractive, and carries the burden of its alcohol very well. Satsuma plum and sundry spice-poached black fruits, licorice and oak all join the flavour queue, tannins the finishing line.



## 95 POINTS TITT

### Bishop Shiraz 2012

Deep crimson – purple; a scaled down version of Amon-Ra, elegance substituted for the flamboyant concentration of Amon-Ra, but the flavour spectrum very similar, the only difference a pleasing savoury note on the finish of this wine.



# 93 POINTS TITT

#### Wallace Shiraz Grenache 2012

Good colour; a light to medium-bodied blend, led by the shiraz that invests the wine with a spicy, gently savoury edge, balanced by the sweeter, juicier grenache; minimal tannin impact.
