2020 Bishop – 93 points

Shiraz sourced from 35-to 120-year old vines in the Ebenezer subregion; matured for 16 months in a mix of 405 new oak and 605 second and third-use hogsheads, mostly French. Purple red in the glass with notes of macerated blackberry and plum fruits, crème de cassis, baking spices, dark chocolate, blackberry cream, earth and violets. Ripe and plush with melt-in-the-mouth tannins, this is very much the quintessential northern Barossa shiraz and a very sharp price.

This 2020 Bishop Shiraz is a saturating and pure example of Barossa Shiraz, from a warm, compacted and low-yielding vintage. The wine in the glass is the very essence of Barossa, with red, earthy tannins, spicy/toasty oak and a fruit profile that spans red, purple and black. Really well done. Delicious.
